Clinics for September

I pm Cliff Olson - Large Scale Prototype Operation

This clinic will look into some of the unique benefits and challenges of prototypical operations in 1.5" scale, or "Live Steam" railroading. All aspects including yard and road operations, radio dispatching, and card way-bill systems will be covered.
