Greeting to WISE Division and NMRA members! May this season be all that you want it to be and to all a very cheerful, safe and Happy New Year. The WISE Division Assistant Superintendant Joe Russ and I would like to extend an invitation to participate in a "FILL IN THE SQUARE" contest. This would entail obtaining a minimum 12 inch by 12 inch foam square at the January 15 WISE Division meet in order to create your own MINI SQUARE diorama. Some of the squares may not be exactly 12 inches by 12 inches but should be close. These MINI Squares should consist of the following as a minimum to be considered.

- 1. Must have a minimum of 2" of track based on the scale being modeled. HO as an example.
- 2. Must make use of some type of scenery material. Foam, plaster, paper,
- 3. If structures are included, a minimum of one (1) structure needs to be railroad-themed.

That's it! Now is time to use your imagination and to have some fun. Your "creation" should be brought to the April 23, 2017 meet for Judging and recognition. We will also have the traditional categories and contest as well that month. Hope to see you and your MINI SQUARE there!


